Lions Meet 'Bama In First Liberty Bowl

Philadelphia, Pa., Dec. 18-The Liberty Bowl, an infant among the major post season games, takes its first big step here tomorrow when Penn State and Alabama clash in Philadelphia Stadium at 1:05 p.m.

A crowd of 40,000 is expected to watch the battle between two of the top teams in the nation. The game will be televised nationally by NBC.

Alabama, ranked 10th in the final Associated Press grid poll, comes into the first Liberty Bowl game with a 7-1-2 record. The Nittany Lions, ranked 10th by United Press International, finished the season with an 8-2 mark.

Only Southeastern Conference champ Georgia beat Bear Bryant's Crimson Tide while Tennessee and Vanderbilt held the Tide to ties
