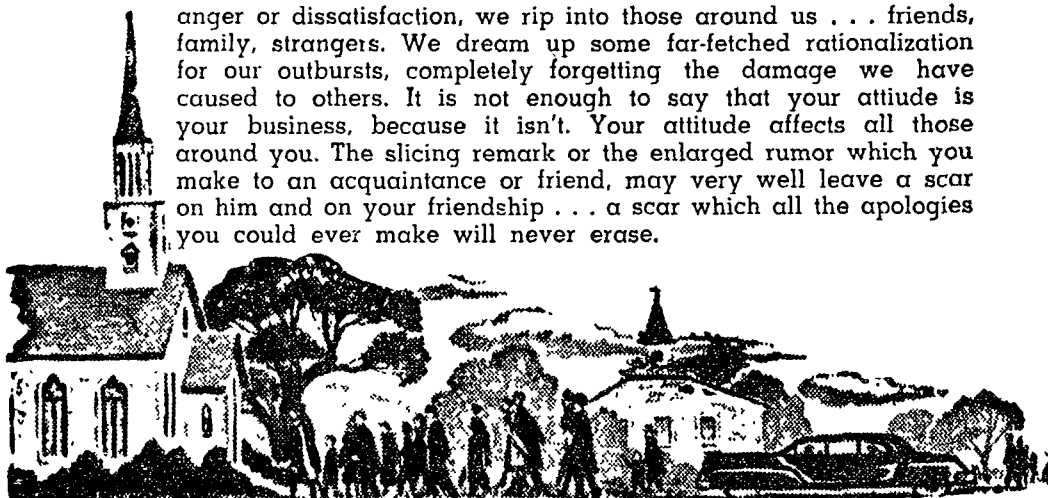


COME TO CHURCH



Positive and Negative Giving

We often speak of people in terms of their personalities. The type of personality a person has is largely dependent on how much of his self he gives to others and how much he keeps for himself. The slicing remark or the enlarged rumor which you make to an acquaintance or friend, may very well leave a scar on him and on your friendship . . . a scar which all the apologies you could ever make will never erase.
