

Probation Given For Offense In Dining Hall

A student who had made unauthorized use of a West Halls dining hall and refused to identify himself when questioned by the residence hall counselor has been placed on probation indefinitely by the dean of men's office.

He also will not be allowed to visit in West Halls except in the room of the person he wishes to see.

The Off-Campus Tribunal which heard the case had recommended suspended disciplinary probation to the dean's office for the student. However, because the student's testimony to the court was full of contradictions and not verified by the counselor, the dean of men's office placed him on probation with the stipulation that if he is involved in any more incidents, he will automatically be placed on disciplinary probation.
