

Yale, Jaspers Rated Over State in IC4A's

Manhattan and Yale are rated co-favorites to dethrone Penn State's defending IC4A indoor track champions in the 39th annual meet Saturday at Madison Square Garden.

The Lions will be competing with aspiring contingents from 47 colleges throughout the nation. Besides all the top eastern powers, squads from Notre Dame, Maryland and Marquette will attempt to displace the Lions.

Although the experts rate the Jaspers and Eli's as the two top possibilities to capture this year's team title, Penn State is by no means out of the running.

In sprinter Bobby Brown and middle distance runners Dick Engelbrink and Steve Moorhead, the Lions have three men who are capable of accumulating valuable first place points.

Brown has looked more impressive in each outing this year. Last Saturday he breasted the tape in 6.2 seconds in the Knights of Columbus Meet, beating national indoor champ Paul Winder by almost a full step.

Although only a sophomore, Moorhead has come along fast. In time trials last week he set a new Rec Hall record for the 880. He was clocked in 1:53 flat. He also looked impressive in racing to a 2:15 victory in the 1000 earlier in the year against Navy and Pitt.

Engelbrink, who won the IC4A 2-mile title in both indoor and outdoor competition last year, will try to make it three in a row. The Nittany captain is also a top contender in the mile.

Other possible point-getters

for the Lions are Dick Campbell and John Fareira in the high jump, Herm Weber and Denny Johnson in the mile, Dick Gross and Dale Peters in the pole vault, Fareira in the hurdles and the 2-mile relay.

The meet will be scored on a five point basis, with six entries in each field.

"The form sheets, as made by the leading track writers who pride themselves in being traditionally accurate," said Lion Coach Chick Werner, "give both Brown and Engelbrink five points."

Moorhead is a threat to capture the mile, and Engelbrink is rated as one of the top contenders in the 2-mile.

However, perennial powerhouse Manhattan has come up with another fine squad loaded with talent and depth. And Yale is rated even better than the Jaspers by some experts.

"Where we have one good man Manhattan has two," said Werner, "and where Manhattan has two Yale has three."

Villanova, Maryland, Notre Dame, Army and Navy will also be in the running.

TKE, AChiRho, 'Mice' Win In IM Swim Tournament

TKE, Alpha Chi Rho, and the "Mice" moved closer to the final round of the IM swim tournament with wins last night at Glennland Pool.

TKE romped over Phi Sigma Delta 32-8, AChiRho won a hard fought meet with Alpha Zeta 26-15, and the "Mice" took a 31-8 decision from Nittany 25.

Led by Bob Metzler, the "Mice" copped every first place. Metzler, who holds the IM breast stroke record, won his specialty with a 36.3 and then took the freestyle with a 32.5.

Teamates Charley Creese and John Apple looked impressive in winning the back stroke and the living respectively. Creese's

time was 42.3 while Apple compiled an 18.6 in the diving.

A 1:01.1 win in the relay rounded out the one-sided victory for the "Mice."

Phi Sigma Delta copped only one first place and three thirds and as a result TKE had an easy night. TKE's scores in the racing events weren't very high, but Jerry Jackson ran up an 18.9 to take the diving.

Al Egolf of TKE won the free style, while teammate Jim Cober won the back stroke. Phi Sig's only winner came in the breast stroke when Jerry Karp breezed home in 51.3.

AChiRho's depth was the deciding factor in their win over Alpha Zeta.

Bill Eberhardt was AZ's top performer, compiling a 17.6 in diving. Rick Holme gave AZ another first in the freestyle.

Eric Whorral and Jerry Zeigler took two of AChiRho's three first place finishes. Whorral won the back stroke, while Zeigler took the breast stroke. AChiRho also won the relay.

Villanova-Detroit Game Opens NIT Next Week

OAKLAND, Calif. (P) — Players and schedules will be the top topics at a two-day meeting, starting today, of the new American Football League.


