

# Enrollment Ends Monday For Leadership Training

Registration for the spring semester Leadership Training program closes at noon Monday, according to James Ettelson, chairman.

Students may sign up for this 8-week course at the Hetzel Union desk. The first meeting will be 7 p.m. Monday in 214 Boucke.

"The purpose of the course isn't to train leaders, but to instruct on the qualities of leaders and to present the problems of leadership and how they could be handled," Ettelson said.

Several speakers have already been selected for the program. Among them are Dr. Paul D. Holtzman, associate professor of speech; Dr. Earl P. Strong, assistant dean of the College of Business Administration; Dr. Emory J. Brown, associate professor of agricultural education and rural sociology; and Capt. Langhorne P. Withers, associate professor of military science and tactics.

Topics to be covered are the psychology of leadership, the importance of speech, parliamentary procedure, and the qualities of a leader and public relations.

Military leadership and committee structure are also included. Practical work and a practical test are a part of this non-credit course. Use of a manual, which costs \$1, will be continued.

Ettelson said that over 200 people, the largest group so far, finished the course last semester.

(Continued from page one) terminated without actually taking a poll. Whereupon David Byers said, "Well, we might take an educated guess."

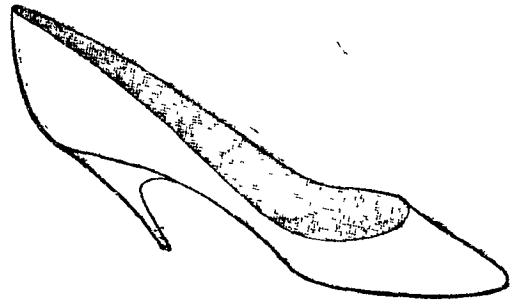
He also added that if Assembly members did not know the opinions of their classmates, then "someone here is not doing their job."
