

Sobczak, Pae Record Wins In IM Wrestling Tournament

Penn State football players were in the limelight last night at Rec Hall as the IM wrestling tournament moved into its second week of competition.

Lion fullback Sam Sobczak took a 5-3 decision over trackman Jon Musser in the top heavyweight bout of the evening, and backfield mate Dick Pae came through with a pin over Bill Mitchell of ATO in their 167-pound bout.

The fastest pin of the night was recorded by Delta Upsilon 150-pounder Bob Sommons when he threw Dick Ronezka of Phi Mu Delta in 40 seconds.

Chuck Munroe of Chi Phi and Bob Alman of Delta Upsilon also recorded quick pins. Munroe pinned Acacia 150-pounder John Witmer in 1:30 while Alman topped Jack Lesyk of Theta Xi in their 128-pound bout.

Four shutouts also were posted last night. George Saba of Sigma Chi turned in an impressive win with a 9-0 decision over Delta Theta Sigma's Jon Mayhew in the 142-pound class.

Footballer Al Maiello bested Dick Stuby of Alpha Gamma Rho, 2-0, in one of the fastest moving matches of the night in the heavyweight class.

In the only independent match, Larry Anderson topped Andy Funk, 8-1, on four takedowns.

In the only referee's decision of the night, Sam Mac Mullen of Phi Kappa Psi beat Russ Charlesworth of Pi Kappa Alpha after the match ended, 2-2.

Wrestling will continue this week and next, with finals scheduled for April 8 on the Rec Hall mats.
