"Coeds, Community and Cooperation, the Three C's of the Future," will be the topic of the Leonides Conference sent to 75 outstanding independent women for the all-day affair.

Three one-hour workshops, have been planned for the conference, scheduled for Sunday, April 24, Leonides Council decided last night.

The conference will be held from 10 a. m. to 5 p. m. in the Nittany Lion Inn. A buffet breakfast and lunch and a coffee break will be served.

The conference is designed to give all independent women a chance to talk over their problems and discuss the future development of independent women's organizations on campus.

Letters of invitation will be sent to 75 outstanding independent women for the all-day affair.

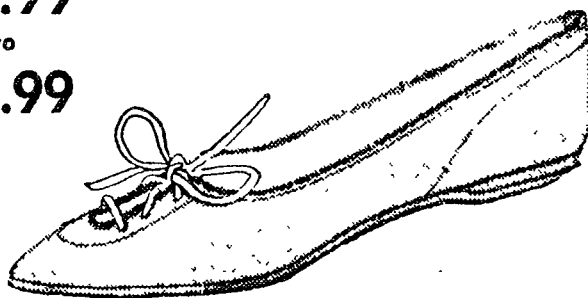

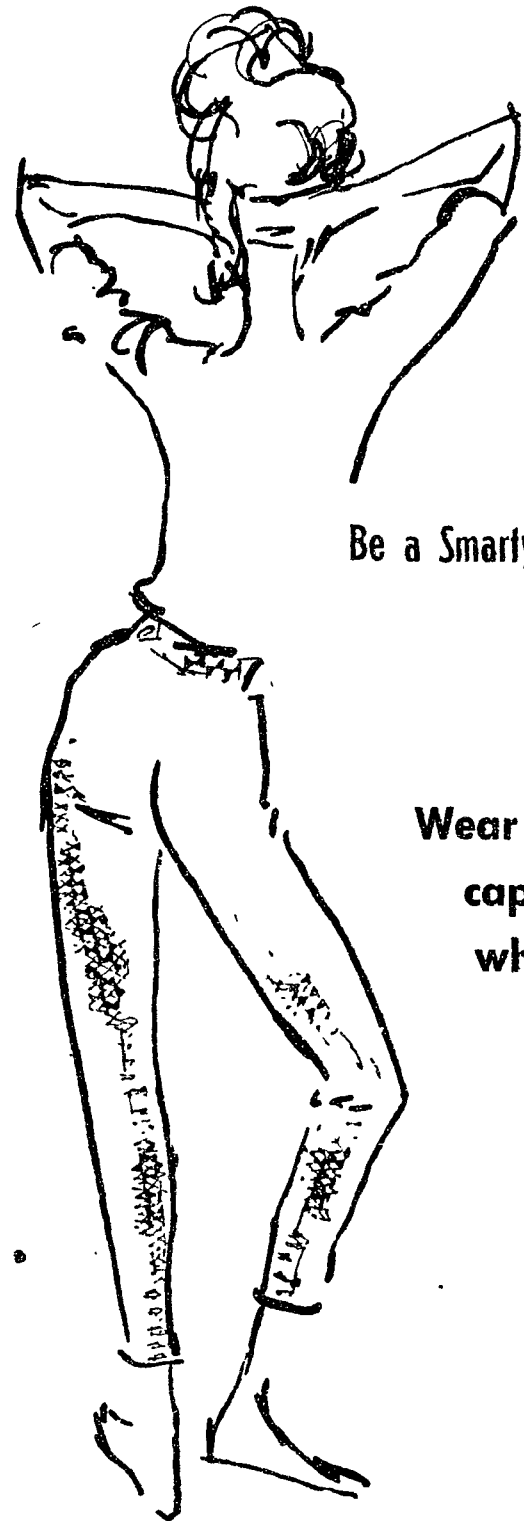
