

Institute Opens For Science, Math Teachers

High school science and mathematics teachers from 16 states and two foreign countries are attending the National Science Foundation Summer Science Institute, which opened yesterday.

A total of 165 teachers from Alaska to Argentina will take part in the six-week study program designed to make teachers members of the science profession as well as the education profession.

The high school teacher is the key man in improving the science level of the citizenry in line with the request of Congress when establishing the institute, said Dr. William H. Powers, director.

The teachers will select specialized courses in their field of science and participate in a common program of activities and research observations.

Four distinguished visiting foreign scientists will lecture at the institute. Dr. Roger Cayrel from France, Dr. A. L. Blakers from Australia, Dr. Aubin Heyndrickx from Belgium and Dr. M. Rueff from Switzerland will speak.

The teachers attending the institute were selected from nearly 900 applicants.

More than 25 per cent of the foreign students who studied here this year were concentrated in California and New York, with California (13.3 per cent) leading New York (12.5 per cent).

For the third consecutive year, the University of California is the institution with the largest number (1,918) of foreign students registered.

Howard University in Washington, D.C., in terms of total enrollment, had the highest percentage of foreign students with 13.6.

The largest number of foreign students (17,175) come from the Far East and the second largest number (9,428) from Latin America. The rapidly developing students (7,110) here for study than did Europe (6,362). Canada is the single country sending the largest number of students to the United States.

Engineering, which claims 11,279 of the students, is the most popular field of study and the humanities with 9,246 second.

At Penn State, the largest percentage of the foreign students are graduate students who work as assistants in instruction and research. Most of these are directed to Penn State through government organization such as the Institute for International Education. More than 200 letters from foreign applicants arrive monthly at the University.
