

# Grant Given For TV Education

The Department of Health, Education and Welfare has awarded the University a grant of \$159,885 for research and development of programmed courses adapted for presentation over closed-circuit television.

Dr. C. R. Carpenter, director of the division of academic research

and services, and Dr. L. P. Greenhill, associate director of the division, are directing the project on which other University personnel in the fields to be covered by the courses are cooperating.

The research program is designed to develop means of adapting programming methods of teaching basic college courses in mathematics and English composition for presentation over closed-circuit television.

The television presentations will be integrated with paced and regulated study-learning schedules for large groups of college students.

The researchers hope to compare the effectiveness, in terms of learning, of teaching the same material by closed-circuit television, by individual "tutorial study" and by conventional teaching methods.

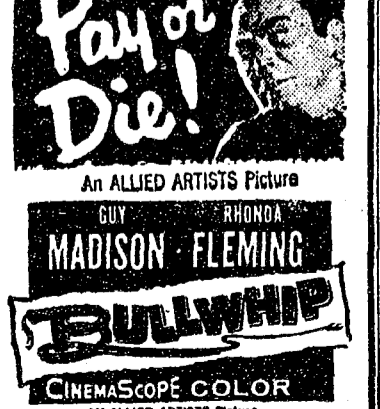

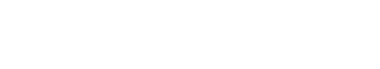
