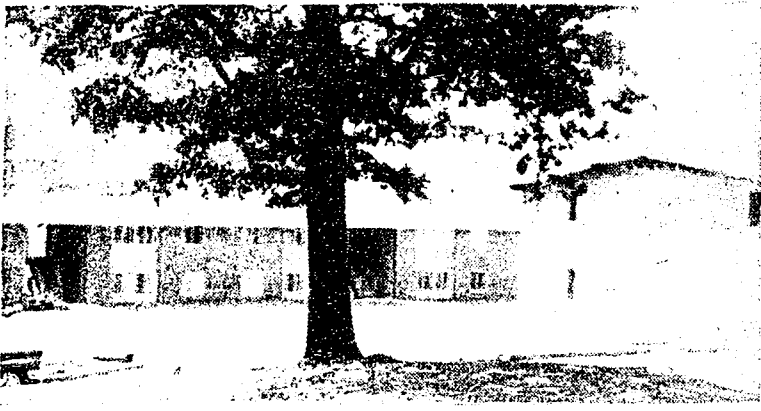
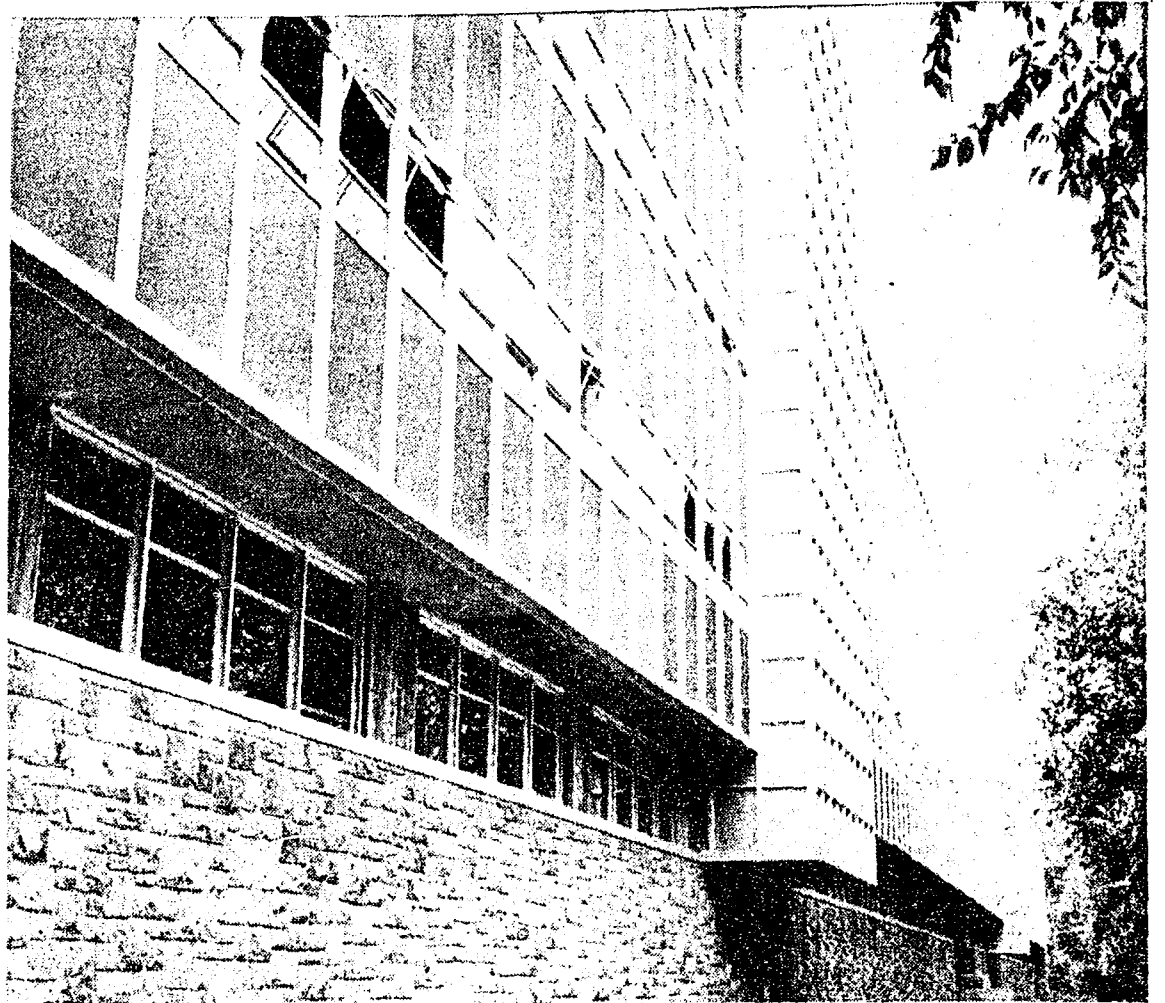


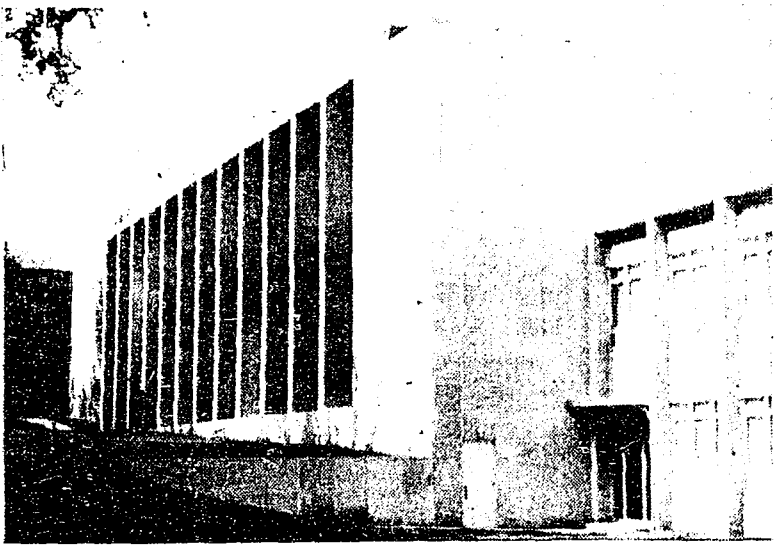
"Pillars of Progress" — 1960



DIAPERS AND WEDDING RINGS are the main features of this new housing development. The buildings are part of the married student housing program, located at the extreme eastern end of campus.

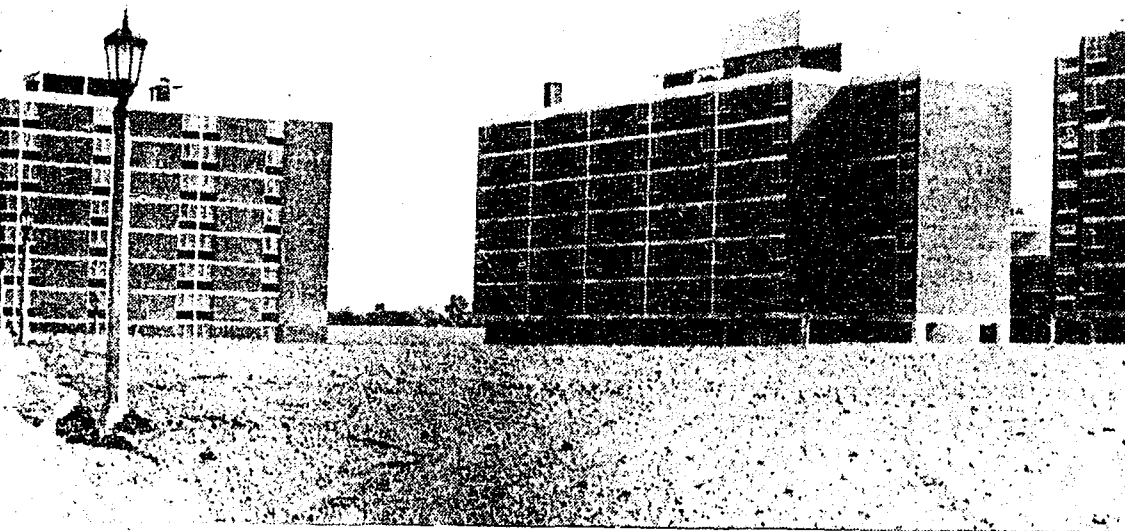

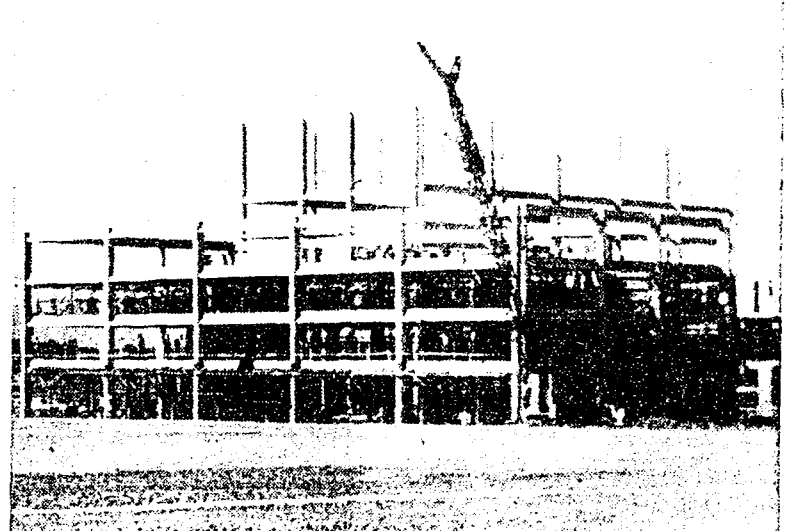


HOME EC MAJORS will benefit from the use of this new building. It is located on the Little Mall.

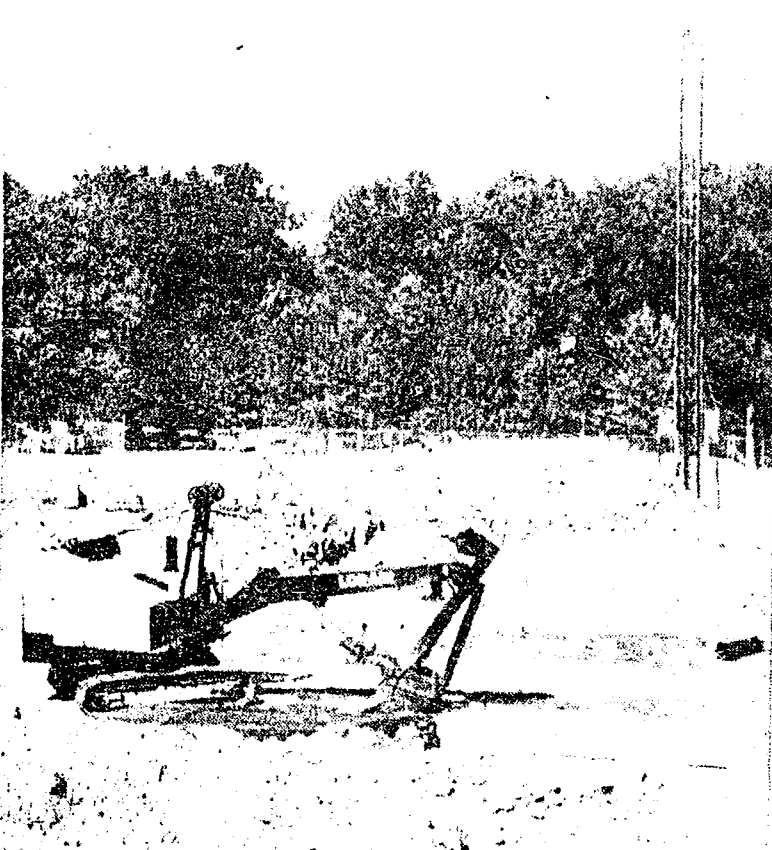

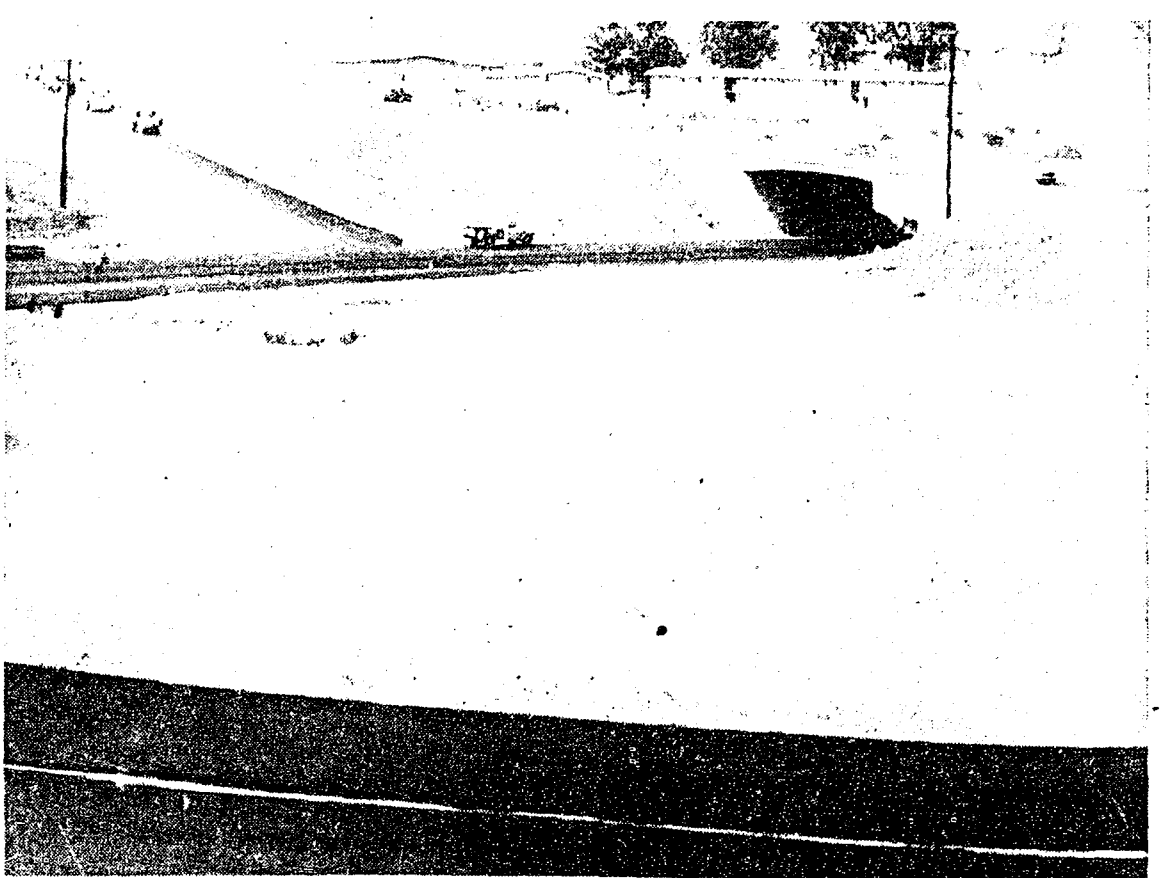
THE POLLOCK RESIDENCE HALLS are ready for occupancy for the first time this year. They will house over 2000 students and nine sororities in six dorms.
