For the many members of the club who have never skied before, there are instruction classes to teach the basic ski techniques through films and group instruction.

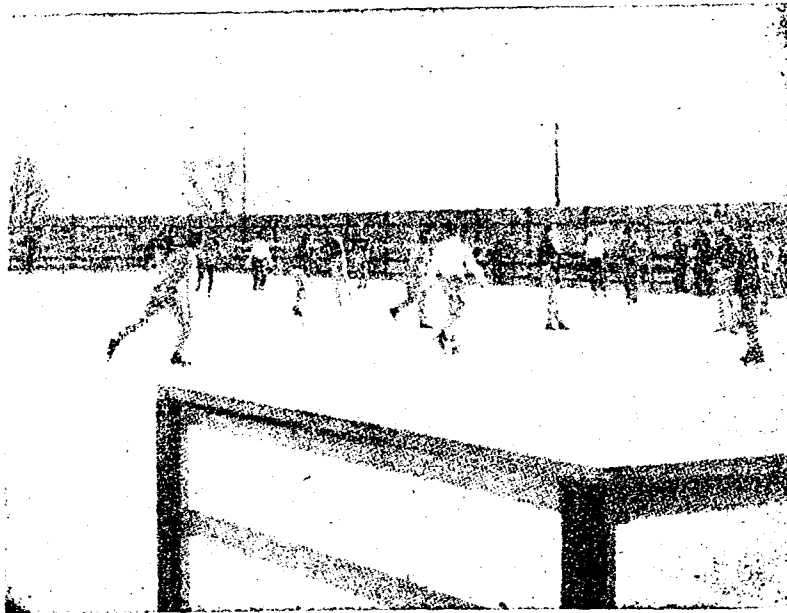
Equipment includes:
