# Color Marks Beaver Stadium Parking Areas

The traditional blue and white won't be the only colors featured at Beaver Stadium during the football season. Beginning with today's game, red, yellow, green and black will also make their appearances as part of a new traffic and parking pattern.

The plan designates specific parking areas by color. Parking spaces may be purchased for the season by ticket-buyers. Also available are parking spaces for individual games. Unreserved spaces further from the field will be available on the day of the game for a smaller fee.

Those who have reserved season spaces have been given large stickers with 2-inch high letters "red." Those having spaces for individual games have stickers lettered "green," while press and official guests have "yellow" stickers. The black designates the unreserved area.

Traffic to and from the stadium parking areas should flow smoothly. All 2-way roads, with one exception, will continue as 2-way roads.

The exception will be the section of Curtin Rd. Extension at the stadium. From 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. this section will be one-way going east and from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. will be one-way going west.

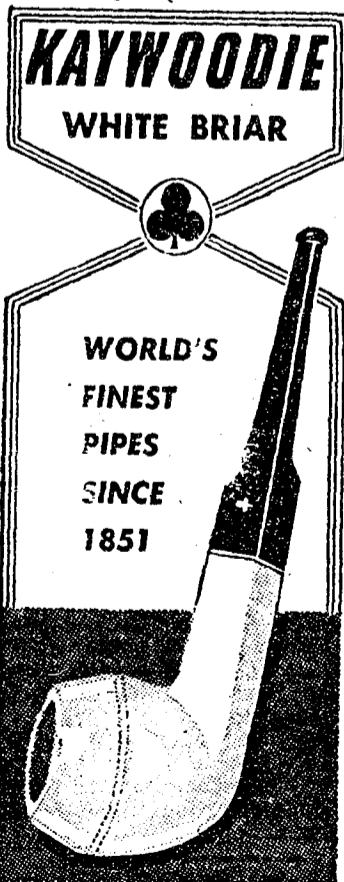
