

**Labor Conference**

Dr. J. J. Kaufman, professor of economics, has participated in a conference of over 100 railroad labor officials sponsored by the New York State School of Industrial and Labor Relations, Cornell University, and the five operating brotherhoods.

The conference was held last week at Ithaca, N.Y.

At the conference Dr. Kaufman presented a paper on the trends and experiences in the railroad industry with respect to handling the technological displacement of railroad workers. He noted that currently railroad workers face a loss of jobs as a result of the attempt of the railroads to change the working rules and to merge and consolidate. He indicated that there are certain special problems facing railroad workers, pointing to their high degree of immobility.

A report was compiled by All-University Cabinet in 1958 listing facilities recommended for inclusion in subsequent HUB expansion plans.

This report called for additional large and small lounges, art workshops, a 1000-seat auditorium, more reading and music practice rooms and listening booths, additional offices and meeting rooms, bowling alleys and expansion of the Lion's Den, game room, Book Exchange and cafeteria.

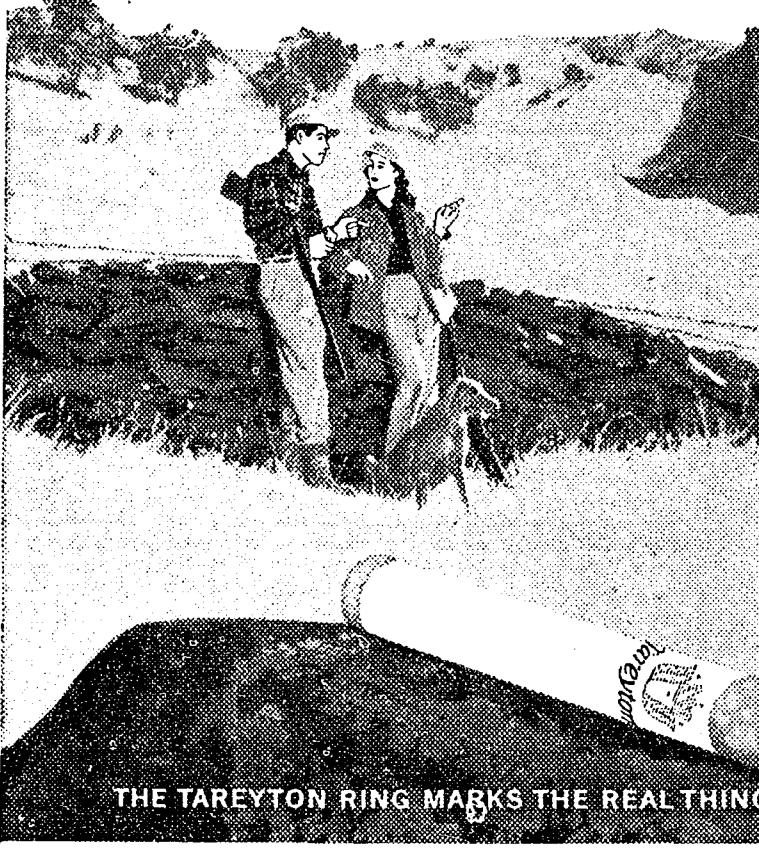

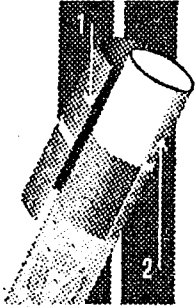
