

Women's Judicial Board Acts on Dorm Violations

Pollock and McElwain-Simmons area judicial committees acted Tuesday on cases concerning violations of the sign-out rules, failure to attend fire drills, and a case involving a coed being out of the residence hall after hours.

A penalty of one week's withdrawal of hours was issued by the Pollock board to the girl who had been out after hours. Two one o'clock withdrawals were given to another coed who opened a locked side door in order to let the first coed back into the dormitory.

Two coeds who had left campus for weekend travel without the signature of their parents on traveling permission slips were also brought before Pollock judicial. One case was dismissed as a misunderstanding while a letter requesting clarification will be sent to the parents of another girl by the dean of women's office.

Another letter was sent to the parents of a coed who slept overnight in another residence hall. A penalty of two one o'clock withdrawals was also issued.

McElwain-Simmons judicial heard the cases of three girls who had failed to sign in or out on leaving the residence halls in the evening. Depending on individual cases, the girls are required to sign in and out in the presence of their hostesses for a period of five to nine days.

Two girls were also warned by the McElwain-Simmons board for failure to attend fire drills. Sandra Slish, chairman of the central judicial committee, said that in the future the area committees will issue penalties for inattendance at fire drills.

Following his speech yesterday, Scott said he favors use of the oath of allegiance alone. People should be "at least willing to take that," Scott added.

He said, though, that he had taken the disclaimer statement many times and it had never hurt him.

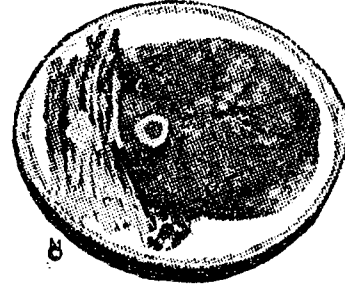
