

Nittany Soccermen Face Temple Today

Penn State's boosters, with high hopes for a winning season after last week's upset over Navy, meet a tough Temple squad at 11 this morning in Philadelphia.

The Nittany soccermen have a 2-4 record to date and need wins in their remaining three games to finish on top in the victory column.

But Temple, with All-American Bill Charlton and top scorer Len Lucenko leading a high powered offense, have other ideas.

In fact, undefeated West Chester is the only team to score a victory over the Owls this year.

Temple has downed Bucknell, 5-0; Wagner, 5-0; Hofstra, 10-2; LaSalle, 2-0; and Lafayette, 8-0.

The Lions started off their campaign on the wrong foot, losing to Bucknell (5-2) and West Chester (5-0) before re-

cording a victory over Syracuse (3-0).

State got some bad breaks in their 5-1 loss to Colgate, and then fought Atlantic Coast Conference champ Maryland right down to the wire before bowing, 4-1.

Last week State surprised previously undefeated Navy, 1-0.

Howie Farrer, a high scoring junior, will again lead the Lion attack at center-forward. Flanking Farrer at wing will be Russ Naylor and Lee Lantz, who is subbing for the injured Lou Van Rafelghem.

Val Djurdjevic and Gene Raiford will start at the inside posts.

Carlos Astiz, Bill Rierson and Jay Stormer get the nod at right-back with John Miller and captain Wayne Rodgers at fullback. Dave Grubbs will be the goalie.
