

# Spartans, Terrapins, Army IC4A Threats

Penn State may be the only undefeated cross country team in the East this season, but there are several other Eastern powers who could give the Lion harriers a tough time in the IC4A meet next Monday in New York.

Penn State coach Chick Werner lists Michigan State, Army, and Maryland as the teams his Lions will have to beat to gain the eastern title.

Michigan State, which has dominated the IC4A in recent years, will be Penn State's chief competition even though the Spartans lost to the Lions earlier this year.

Army, losers only to Air Force, also rate as one of the East's top teams.

The Cadets have scored wins over Providence, Syracuse, and Manhattan and last Friday they closed out the season by beating all the Ivy League schools to win the Octagonal Championship.

Werner had a good chance to scout the Cadets because the Octagonal meet was held at Van Cortlandt Park right after Penn State defeated Manhattan in a dual meet.

"By a comparison of our times against Manhattan, and Army's times in the Octagonals, they would have beaten us. But they were running in a championship meet and the incentive there is certainly greater than in a dual meet," Werner said.

Rozelle said if the stock is not sold by Dec. 8 it would be offered at public sale. Wisner, also a sports announcer, has a 26 per cent interest in the Redskin club.


