NSF to Finance Reactor Research

The National Science Foundation has awarded a facility grant of \$168,126 to the University for support of "equipment for expanding basic nuclear reactor research in the natural and engineering sciences."

Forrest J. Remick, acting director of the Nuclear Reactor Facility, will be in charge of the grant. Funds will be used to increase the flexibility and safety of the campus reactor and will aid in the building expansion program by providing for specialized equipment for education and research.

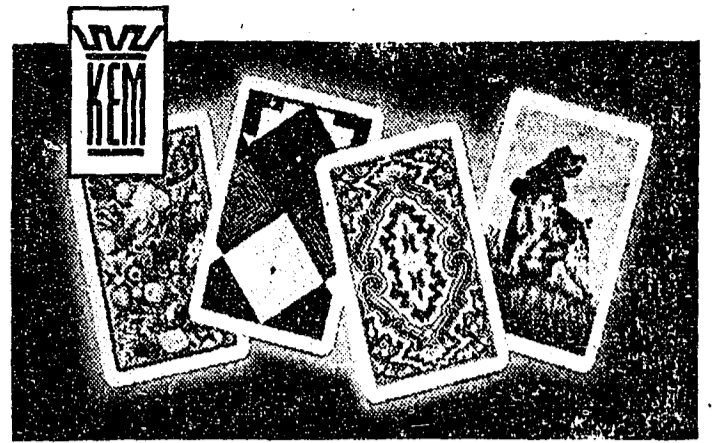
