The Parking Development Corp. found these two projects the "only hope for immediate improvement of the parking situation." Hertzfeld said. At present, cars can generally park on streets adjacent to the University buildings for only two hours.

The projects are just the first steps in the University's longrange parking program, Hertzfeld added.

Boston University is located in one of the leading educational centers of the world and also the cultural center of New England. Most of the buildings are on Commonwealth Ave. and Bay State Rd. between Kenmore Square and the Boston University Bridge. The University has three residence halls for men and 15 for women.
