# SGA OK's Impeachment Amendment

SGA Thursday night gave final approval to an amendment which clarifies the impeachment procedure for Assembly members.

In effect, the new ruling makes the already existing impeachment procedures for SGA officers applicable to all Assembly members.

The SGA constitution in the past had not stipulated exactly how Assemblymen were to be impeached, although it did specify that they could be impeached. The clarification became necessary when SGA Rules Committee was considering the legality of the absences of three members late in October.

The three had been absent at least three times, which is a violation of Assembly's procedural rules. These rules, in part, prohibit more than three absences.

Robert Harrison, chairman of rules committee, clarified this procedural rule at the time by saying that the validity of absences should be taken into account after "removal procedures are promulgated."

There must be a two-thirds vote of Assembly to launch the impeachment of an officer or Assemblyman. The chairman of the Supreme Court then hears the case, with the remainder of Assembly serving as jury.

The defendant can then plead his case and may have one advisor with him. This is the only time that the legality or illegality of the defendants' absences can be taken into account, Harrison added.

# WDFM to Conduct Audience Survey

WDFM station personnel will conduct a random survey of its listening audience beginning after the Christmas holidays. The survey, which will be held by phone, will include the student, faculty and State College resident audience.

Information from the survey will show the estimated size of the listening audience and will indicate the hours of greatest listening coverage. Future station programming will be based on these findings, Sally Layton, station publicity director, said.

# ISA Approves Plan to Operate In All Terms

The Independent Student Association approved a recommendation Wednesday that the organization should actively operate during all four terms.

ISA members felt that since in the past no independent group was active during the summer session, there was an inadequate social program for independent students and that if ISA remained active all year-round this situation would be remedied.

It was also recommended that to be eligible for the office of president an independent student should be required to have an All-University average of 2.4 or higher and that other officers maintain an All-University average of 2.2 or higher.

The average of 2.4 for president was set because ISA members thought anyone with a lower average would not have the free time required of the president of a major campus organization.
