(Continued from page one) by a faculty committee but the final decision on hiring would be up to the SGA Assembly. In dismissing the secretary, Brandt said that his contract could be renewed or dropped by an Assembly referendum.

Brandt did not specify a time for the implementation of his proposal. He did say, however, that the plan does not require a time lag and could be put into operation at any time.

The proposal, according to Brandt, would provide a continuity in student government that cannot be accomplished by a student government which is con-

stantly changing personnel. He also said that a full-time secretary would help to solve many of the problems arising in the change-over to the four-term system.
