

AWS Judicial Asks Discipline For 2 Coeds

The AWS Central Judicial Board Wednesday night recommended to Dean of Women Dorothy J. Lipp, that a woman who let her friend in through a locked door to her residence hall at 1:17 a.m. be placed on disciplinary probation.

The board recommended that the coed, who is already on office and academic probation, appear before the Senate Sub-Committee on Discipline.

Three successive Saturday 1 a.m. withdrawals were given to the other coed.

In other business, the rule that a student may not return to school between semesters earlier than 24 hours before he registers has been changed, Mary Melusky, assistant Pollock Halls coordinator, announced. The vacation officially ends Tuesday, Jan. 31. Students may return to their residence halls starting 8 a.m. Tuesday. The changing of this rule was necessitated by travel inconveniences and advisors' requests.

The board decided to eliminate entirely the yellow travel and weekend sign-out sheets. This means that students will use the regular white sign-out sheets.

The only 1 a.m. travel permission will be given Tuesday night. On Wednesday and Thursday the residence halls will close at 11:30 p.m. as usual.

New Soc Course Will Be Offered

For the benefit of students interested in working in underdeveloped countries following their graduation, a course called "Community Development in Underdeveloped Areas," will be offered next semester.

The course will be administered by the Department of Agricultural Economics and Rural Sociology. Undergraduates may schedule it as a three-credit course by enrolling in Rural Sociology 452 and graduate students as a two-credit course, by enrolling in Rural Sociology 551.

National Teachers Exam Will Be Offered Feb. 11

Dr. Andrew V. Kozak, associate professor of education, who is in charge of the examination said that application forms are available in 311 Burrowes.

Applications submitted after tomorrow must be accompanied by a late registration fee.

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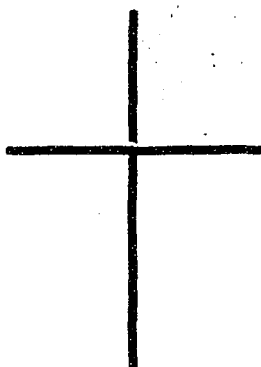
