

# TIM, Boro Discuss Land Development

The Town Independent Men's Council is presently negotiating with the Borough Recreation Department to secure permission to develop a tract of land into four baseball diamonds, according to Phillip Haines, TIM president.

The area under consideration belongs to the borough and is not being used for anything at the present time, he said.

TIM proposed to provide men and materials for the project, if the borough will supply equipment and give the council permissions to use the field for intramural softball in the spring.

TIM's interest in this field stems from the fact that there are already too many intramural softball teams utilizing the few University facilities which exist and, according to Haines, TIM has had difficulty in the past in running their intramural program, Haines said.

In other business, Haines announced that the Senate Committee on Student Affairs had once again tabled their application for an autonomous charter. The reason for this action is that the committee said it feels that TIM can operate without a charter for the present time just as well as with one, according to a letter which TIM received.

Haines commented, "I dis-

agree wholeheartedly with this decision."

It was also announced at the meeting that the council had acquired the Bell Science Series films and would start showing them shortly on a once-a-week basis.

This is a series of one hour movies which presents the mysteries of science in non-technical form.
