

University to Elect Acting Party Head

University party will elect an acting chairman at its caucus meeting tonight to fill the position vacated by Michael Lazorchak whose resignation became effective March 9.

Lazorchak has resigned because he will be student teaching out of town during the spring elections.

The acting chairman to be elected may serve until spring party registration is completed,

according to Robert Dufner, elections commission chairman. He explained that the position is "interim or acting" because at present there are no party members.

Dufner added that all those carrying University party cards are technically considered unaffiliated with the party since the cards read "Fall Semester." All such memberships expired at the beginning of the spring semester and must be renewed at spring party registration, which begins Sunday.

In the meantime, according to Dufner, there are no political party members. He said that this applies to Campus party also. Liberal party was not established during fall party registration so technically it has no members either.

In electing an interim chairman for University Party, Dufner has decided to open the elections to all students carrying the expired fall membership cards. He said this was done to avoid the impression that a chairman had been forced on the party.

Dufner said that the interim chairman was being elected because "no group can operate without a leader." He added that the only qualification for the position is a fall membership in the party.

Party registration for spring elections will begin Sunday night

and final registration will be completed next Sunday. Attendance at both meetings is required for those planning to vote in the party primary and final nominations. Dufner said that new elections commission members who will serve at party registrations and nominations will come up for approval before SGA Assembly tonight.
