

### Heavy Snow, Cold Expected

Wet snow, possibly heavy at times, should continue through much of today as a winter-like storm moves up the eastern seaboard.

This snow is expected to fall throughout the eastern two-thirds of the Commonwealth today, and accumulations should average between 3 and 6 inches. The heaviest falls will occur in eastern portions of the state, where some sections may get more than 6 inches of snow.

The ground is relatively mild, so snow accumulations will vary considerably. The greatest amounts will occur on grass areas.

The local forecast indicates wet snow, heavy at times and cold today with a high temperature of 36 degrees. No drifting or blowing snow is expected.
