In many ways, "Operation Pennsylvanians will get a Crossroads Africa" was a fore-

lege campuses lived and worked for two months with tribal groups in rural areas building schoolhouses, hospitals, community centers and digging drainage ditches, The students met with political and governmental leaders, businessmen and village chiefs. "Operation Crossroads Africa" will be returning to West Africa this summer, and will provide students with an experience similar, to the future Peace Corps.

Robinson intends to concentrate on the continent of Africa for the next five years, taking another group to West Africa in 1961 and wo pilot projects to East Africa. His schedule includes enlarging the groups in East Africa, getting into Central Africa and eventually into South Africa.


