

Hayes, Seelig Draw Praise Despite Stickmen's 1-5 Log

Penn State has only had three All-American lacrosse players since it began the sport in 1913, but Tom Hayes and Dick Seelig, a couple of sophomores, just might jump the total to five.

State has won only one game so far this year but the sophomore stars have done everything asked of them. Hayes and Seelig have combined for 27 goals, over half of the team total of 46.

Hayes, a midfielder, is the leading scorer with 14 goals in five games and Seelig, an attack player, is only one goal behind in six games.

"I've voted for them for the All-America team," Lion coach Earnie Baer said yesterday. "I'd like to see Seelig make honorable mention All-America," Baer said, "and from the talk among coaches I think Hayes can make the All-America team."

Baer, who is vice president of the Lacrosse Coaches Association, is one of 18 coaches on the All-American Advisory Committee who make the final selections.

"From the lacrosse players I've seen in the past 10 years, Hayes could play on any first team in the country," Baer said. "If everyone on the selection committee could see him play, he'd be voted at least a second team All-American position this year."

Hayes also has made a big impression on other coaches this season. "I've heard so much about Hayes that I was really disappointed when he was injured and couldn't play against us," Syracuse Coach Roy Simmons told Baer.

Hayes had to sit out the Syracuse game because of a charley (Continued on page eight)

Gentile Smashes 2 Grand Slam Homers

ST. PAUL - MINNEAPOLIS (AP)—Jim Gentile smashed two grand slam home runs in a row for a major league record as the Baltimore Orioles crushed the Minnesota Twins 13-5, yesterday.

Gentile teed off on Twins pitchers in the first and second innings when the Orioles ran up a 9-0 lead. That made it easier for Baltimore pitcher Chuck Estrada who gave up two homers himself. Bob Allison hit two homers for the losers, one off Estrada and the other off Gordon Jones, who came on in relief in the eighth.

It was the first time a player had hit two grand slams in a row, but three others in the American League have socked a

pair in one game. It's never been done in the National League.

The handsome, 6-foot-4, 215-pound southpaw first baseman also set a record by batting in eight runs in two consecutive innings. Gentile had shared the record of 7 RBI with seven others. He drove in another run on a sacrifice fly in the eighth inning.

Those who previously had two grand slam homers in a game were Tony Lazzeri, New York Yankees (1936), Jim Tabor, Boston Red Sox (1939) and Rudy York, Boston Red Sox (1946).

Gentile's homers were his eighth and ninth of the season, tying him with Mickey Mantle. He also shot six RBI ahead of Mantle with a total of 30.

Ronnie Hansen poled his third homer, a two-run blow in the Baltimore fifth.
