

Hurricane Esther Aims at New Jersey--

(Continued from page one) come heavy during the day. Winds will also be increasing and may reach 25 to 35 miles an hour by late afternoon. Gusts may reach gale force.

Extreme southeastern Pennsylvania and New Jersey are expected to bear the full brunt of the storm. Wind gusts of 75 to 100 miles an hour may be recorded as far inland as Philadelphia and torrential rain may spread as far west as Harrisburg.

Five to 10 inches of rain may be reported in portions of Delaware, Southeastern Pennsylvania, Southeastern New York, eastern

Maryland and New Jersey.

Small crafts from Cape Ann, Massachusetts, to Jacksonville, Florida, have been urged to remain in port because of rough seas and increasing winds.

Were it not for a large mass of cool air, which brought frost to Pennsylvania over the weekend and now covers New England and the North Atlantic Ocean, the hurricane would probably be heading harmlessly out to sea.

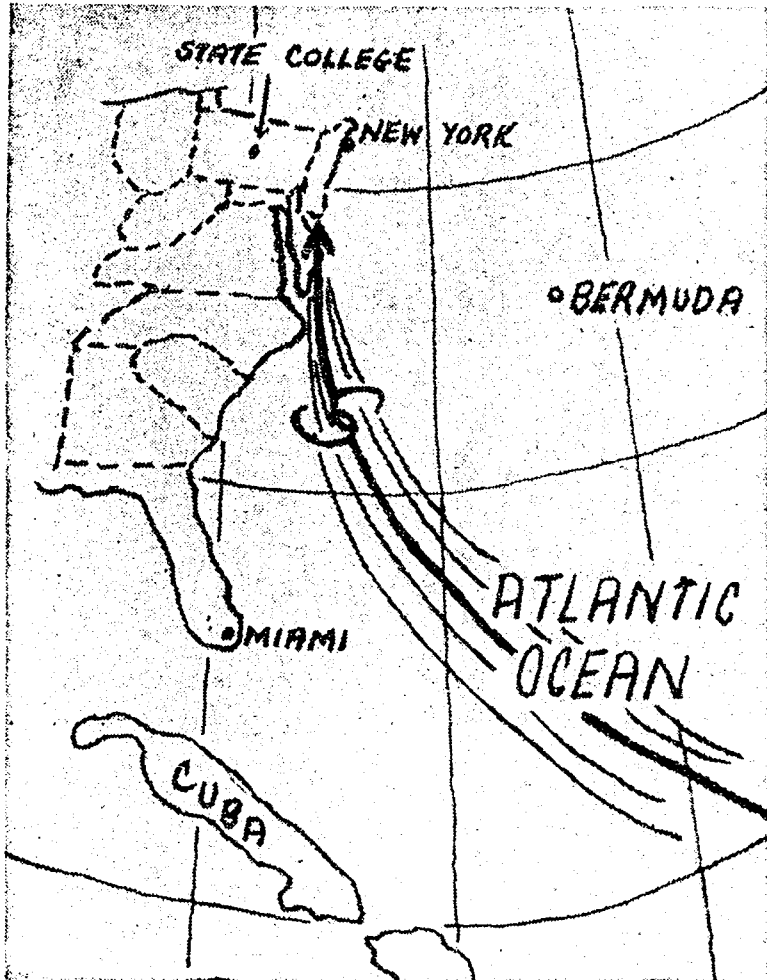
That large cool air mass has remained stationary during the past few days forcing Esther to move on a northwesterly course toward the United States main-

land. The cool air mass is expected to finally begin moving eastward today, but hurricane Esther will probably have reached the mainland by then.

The forecast for this area calls for increasing winds and rain today. Rain may become heavy this afternoon and this evening. Strong to gale winds and rain is expected tonight.

A high of 70 is expected today with a low of 65 indicated for tonight.

Tomorrow should be mostly cloudy, and warmer with winds diminishing.
