Hardin Will Miss Bellino; Plans to Use 3 Teams

Kochman will team with quarterback Pete Liske, right halfback Gary Wydman and fullback Bud-die Torris on Engle's Reddie Unit backfield.

The rest of the Reddie Unit will include Jim Schwab and Dick Anderson at end, Ron Tietjens and Gerry Farkas at tackle, Ralph Baker and Joe Galardi at guard and Bill Saul at center.

State's starting unit has Galen Hall, a two-year veteran, at quarter-back, Don Jonas and Al Gursky at halfback and Dave Hayes at fullback.

Bob Mitinger and Dave Robinson, who Engle calls "two of the finest ends in the country," head a mammoth line that outweighs Navy by 21 pounds. Charlie Sieminski (245) and Captain Jim Smith (230) are at tackle, Joe Blasenstein (200) and Harrison Rosdahl (230) at guard and Jay Huffman (205) at center.

With 17 lettermen, including Joe Bellino, a one-man offense, gone from last year's Orange

Bowl squad, Navy Coach Wayne Hardin can't expect to match the Lions in experience.

The biggest loss is Bellino.

"We have never intended to replace Bellino," Hardin said yesterday when asked who would take the place of famous No. 27. "You just can't replace a player like him," he said. "Our problem is to replace the 20 boys who graduated with him."

Despite the shortage of lettermen, Hardin expects to have three

teams—a two-way unit, an offensive unit and a defensive unit—ready for plenty of action today.

Navy's two-way team, generally regarded as the starting unit, includes Ed Gill and Greg Mather at end, Larry Graham and Ron Testa at tackle, Vern Von Sydow and John Hewitt at guard and Steve Hoy at center.

The backfield shows Ron Kle-mick at quarterback, Jim Stewart and Carl Fink at halfback and Ron Bell at fullback.
