Boyle said that he will hold a qualifying round of his own Sep. 30 to determine who will represent the Lions in the tournament, Bob Swahn, Dave Miller, Jack Meredith, Dick Gilison, all back from last year's squad, and sophomores Jim Tabor, Dave Leibau and Rolland Gartners are State's top golfers.
