

Sittler to Give Chapel Sermon On Parables

Dr. Joseph Sittler, professor of theology at the University of Chicago Divinity School, will speak at the 10:55 a.m. service of worship tomorrow in Schwab Auditorium. His topic will be "How to Read a Parable."

The Chapel Choir, directed by Mrs. Willa C. Taylor, will sing an arrangement of Psalm 100 by Kirche Meham. Dr. Leonard Raver, chapel organist, will play "Prelude and Fugue in D Major," "We Pray to the Holy Spirit," "Fugue in C Major" and "Passacaglia in D Minor," all by Dietrich Buxtehude.

Sittler has served as chairman of the North American Commission of Worship of the World Council of Churches. He has written two books, "The Doctrines of the Word" and "The Structure of Christian Ethics."

The Rev. William Kuhre, graduate student in the department of English, will give the sermon at the Protestant Service of Worship at 9 a.m. tomorrow in the Helen Eakin Eisenhower Chapel. The leader of worship will be Rev. Samuel N. Gibson, executive director of the University Christian Association.
