

Coach Calls Top Teams Face Big Battles

Even with three quarters of his career behind him, Coach Engle still has more to offer than most teams across the country. In left halfback Davis, a bona fide All-American, there ever was one.

"We'll use Davis all we can," Schwartzwelder said, "but how much we use him depends on what kind of defense State uses. If the defense puts three men on him, Davis won't last that long."

Engle's squad is in good condition, but if the silver-haired coach carries out the plans he formulated in practice this week, there will be plenty of changes in the State lineup.

Off his performance against Army, left halfback Roger Kochman has been moved up to the starting backfield. He'll be running with Galen Hall (QB) Dan Jones (RB) and Dave Hayes (FB).

After viewing game films of last week's 10-6 defeat, Engle demoted backfield Jim Smith and Charlie Staminski to the second team and moved up Terry Monaghan and Gerry Farkas to the starting unit.

Engle has made similar changes on the Reddie Unit, but he emphasized that nothing is definite.

Three important streaks will be riding on the outcome of today's game. After the Army defeat last week, Engle is still looking for the 100th win of his coaching career.

He has an overall record of 92-53-3 during six years at Brown and 12 years at State.

Syracuse will be shooting for its fourth consecutive win over the Licens but State still holds a 17-6-5 edge in the series that dates back to 1922.

And last but not least, State will be after its fourth straight win before the TV cameras. In 1958, the Licens whipped Boston U. 34-0 in an eastern regional game and their victories over Alabama and Oregon were achieved in front of coast-to-coast audiences.

Galen Hall in two seasons has completed 57 of 126 passes for 663 yards and seven touchdowns, in addition to gaining 235 yards in 64 carries at the quarterback slot.
