Deardorff, a 5-9, 145-pounder, traveled the five mile course

in 25:32, erasing the old mark of 25:37 set by Midshipman Bob

Kunkle in 1959. "We've been waiting for Howie to break loose all year and after

for first place against Pitt in the season opener his time against the Middies was his best of the year and he has been improving in every outing.


