

Assembly to Meet on Constitution--

to revise the structure and procedures of SGA. At that time the Assembly adjourned to write the constitution in smaller groups, working under a temporary charter granted to SGA by the student affairs committee for the purpose of reorganizing.
The final draft was completed early this fall and after it was checked for legal loopholes by Robert E. Dunham, instructor in parliamentary law, it was submitted to the Senate committees for review.


