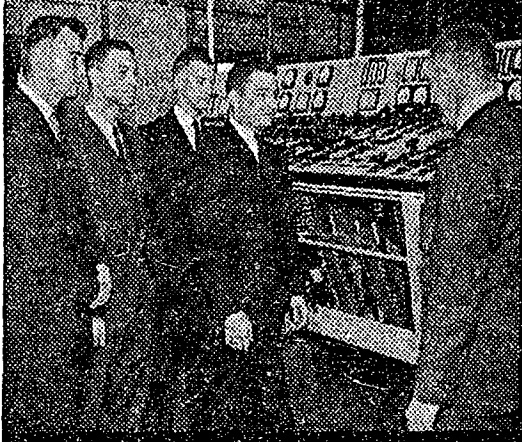

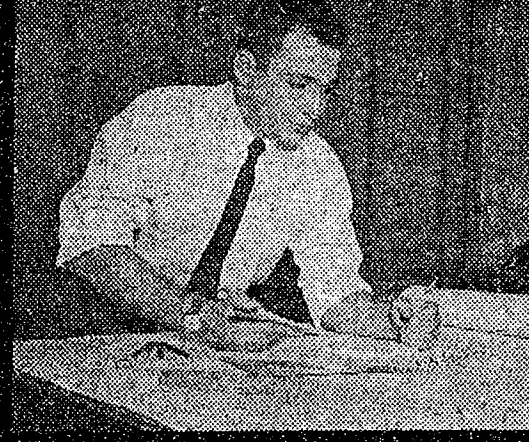
Bill discusses the plans for the construction of a new computer-operated generator unit.



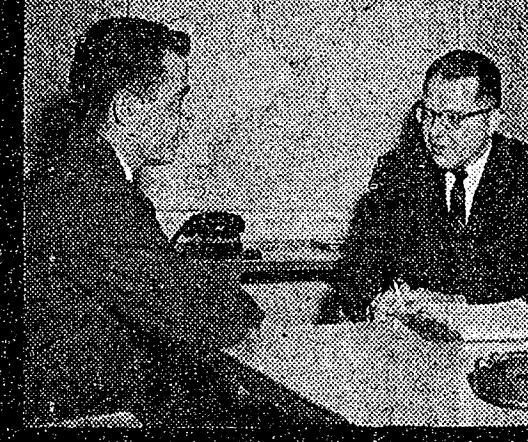
He studies the magnitude of short-circuit current under certain electrical fault conditions.
