

Elections to Take Place In All Residence Areas

There will be an election for student body representatives in every district in the coming elections, according to the list of candidates received by the Daily Collegian yesterday.

Two districts — North Halls women and Nittany men — have only one candidate for the one seat to be filled from the area.

There will be, however, elections in all areas including the two where only one candidate is running, Nancy Williams, elections commission chairman said yesterday.

An elections code, which Miss Williams termed "informal" has been drawn up. This code limits expenditures for candidates for representatives to \$6, \$3 of which may be obtained from the commission. Candidates for class presidencies are permitted to spend \$10 on their campaign. Three dollars of this amount may be obtained from the elections commission.

Campaigning for the Jan. 25

through 27 elections is not permitted to begin until 8 a.m. Jan. 15. Before that date, no campaign materials may be posted or distributed and candidates may not formally meet with voters.

Campaigning during the set period is permitted in student residences only when permitted by authorities. For example, candidates must contact fraternity presidents before campaigning in that fraternity or, in the case of residence halls, the area supervisor.

Campaigning in the dining halls is not permitted, Miss Williams said, but personal campaigning in dining hall lines is allowed.
