

Below Zero Temperatures Due

Today will be the coldest day of the winter, and even lower temperatures are expected tomorrow.

A high temperature of only 8 degrees is predicted for this afternoon, and a low of 4 below zero is indicated for tonight. Tomorrow's high will be about 6 degrees above zero.

Partly cloudy skies, gusty winds and occasional snow flurries should continue through tomorrow. Little or no snow accumulation is expected.

No significant warming trend is expected here for at least five days.

The gigantic mass of bitterly cold arctic air extended its influence southward and eastward yesterday and last night, and most of Canada and the United States and now engulfed by extremely

cold weather. Record-breaking temperatures were recorded further and further south yesterday as the cold wave plunged into the Gulf states.

At the warmest part of yesterday afternoon temperatures ranged from the 30's along the western and central Gulf coast to zero and below in the north-central states.

The mercury failed to reach the zero mark yesterday in Chicago, Milwaukee, Des Moines, and Omaha.

As the extremely cold air dis-

placed the warm tropical air in the Gulf states, snow, sleet and rain developed. Several inches of snow accumulated from Louisiana to Georgia and the Carolinas yesterday and last night.

Snow flurries and squalls in extreme northwestern Pennsylvania and western New York accumulated to a depth of several inches yesterday and last night. Ten to 20 inches of new snow is expected in that area today as brisk westerly winds continue to bring snow squalls inland from Lake Erie and Ontario.
