

# Layoff, Gettysburg Wrinkle Egli's Brow

Sixteen days without a game—that prospect is enough to worry any basketball coach. Add a tough opponent at the end of that long hardcourt recess and you have double trouble. Then top it off with the fact that the opponent is vastly underrated, and you have—well, “a problem,” as Lion cage coach John Egli put it mildly yesterday.

Egli's cagers last saw action Jan. 20 at Carnegie Tech, where they notched their ninth win against seven losses as Gene Harris scored 28 points in a 52-45 victory.

STATE DOESN'T return to battle until Tuesday—16 days from the Tech game, but it's concern over the opponent and not the layoff that has caused a wrinkle in Egli's brow.

The Lions get back into action Tuesday at Rec Hall against Gettysburg, an underrated team with a potential All-Eastern shot-maker, a 9-3 record and a six game winning streak going into last night's game with Muhlenberg.

Snowy Simpson, Egli's assistant, scouted the Bullets last night. His information should help Egli make up his mind on how to defend Ron Warner, the 5-10 senior who has averaged 61.5 points per season his first two years on the varsity.

WARNER WAS a popular choice for All-Middle Atlantic Conference, All-State, All-East and honorable mention All-America as a junior last year.

To add to Egli's worries, the Bullets are playing in a new field house this year, and off their won-lost record, they must have become accustomed to it in a hurry.

Gettysburg has yet to lose at home this year, beating Franklin and Marshall, Dickinson, Lehigh, Johns Hopkins, La Salle and Rutgers.

The Lions resumed practice yesterday after taking a day off Tuesday.

WITH SEVEN GAMES to go and his team two games above the .500 mark, Egli feels State has a fair chance to end up with a winning record—if we beat Gettysburg.

Captain Gene Harris has paced the Lions throughout the season, and is far ahead of his teammates in both scoring and rebounding. The 6-4 jumping jack is scoring an average of 20.4 points a game



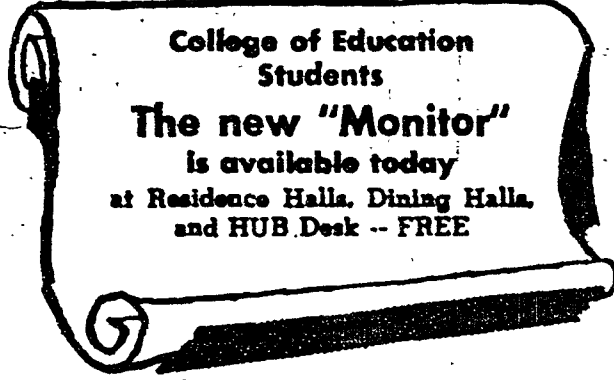

and has grabbed 204 rebounds so far.

Harris' best games came against Holy Cross, when he scored 46 points to wipe out the school record of 44 held by Jesse Arnelle, and against Carnegie Tech, when he almost singlehandedly beat the Tartans with an assortment of long jump shots and driving layups.
