

## Johansson to Quit If He Loses Tonight

GOTEBORG, Sweden (AP) Ingemar Johansson said yester-day he probably will hang up his gloves if he loses tonight's comeback bout to Joe Bygraves. However, Johansson is a 4-1 favorite.

"I want to get back the world title," said the 29-year-old Swede, who won the heavyweight boxing crown from Floyd Patterson in 1959, lost it in 1960 and was knocked out again by Patterson in his last start, March 13, 1961. "If I do well against Bygraves I will keep pushing toward win-ning back the crown. If I lose, then I'll probably hang up my gloves for good."

A sellout crowd of 6,000 will watch the fight at Goteborg's Maesshallen Stadium.

Johansson said he is down to tighting weight of 198 pounds. His record is 22-2 with 14 knockouts.


