Rudd is a United Presbyterian minister. He served from 1957 to

1959 as pastor of Park Central Presbyterian Church in Syracuse, New York.

He will speak on the same topic at the Protestant Service of Worship at 9 a.m. tomorrow in the Helen Eakin Eisenhower Chapel.

The Meditation Chapel Choir, under the direction of James W. Beach, will sing "Deliver Us, O Lord" by Adrian Batten. William Mastrocola will be the organist at the service.

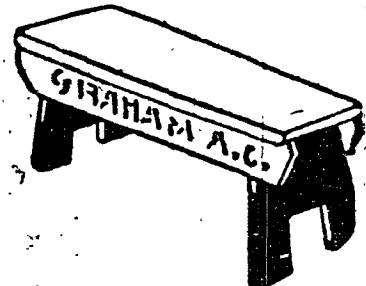

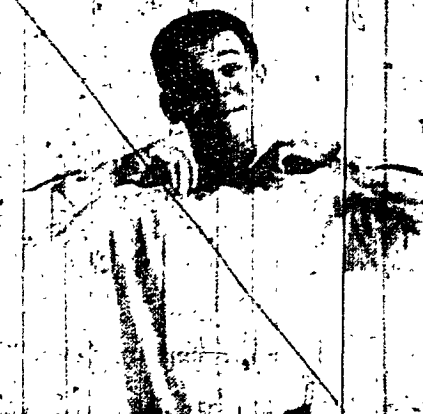
