

TIM Housing Survey to Begin Today

The Town Independent Men's Council will begin a telephone survey of downtown housing conditions today.

Every tenth town independent man listed in the University phone directory will be asked whether his rooming facilities meet certain minimum state housing specifications.

THESE SPECIFICATIONS include a desk, straight chair,

dresser and 100 watt lighting for each student; linen changed and rooms cleaned once a week; a private entrance for each room and a fire escape from the second floor and a bathroom for every 12 students.

Data from this survey will be compiled and discussed at the April 17 TIM Council meeting. A copy of the information and statistics will also be sent to the Borough Council, Gomer Williams, TIM Council housing committee chairman, said.

WILLIAMS SAID that a record of addresses and complaints will be kept on file in the TIM of-

ice. If the Borough Council should establish a committee for housing complaints, he said this record would be rechecked and presented to the council.

There has been much comment on the downtown housing situation but no survey has been taken of the students, Williams said.

In other business at the TIM meeting Wednesday night, the council established a committee to investigate the Minor's Ordinances and laws pertaining to the drinking or possessing of alcoholic beverages by persons under 21. It will also study how these regulations are obeyed by both students and local tavern owners.

University Drill Teams Participate In Annual Cherry Blossom Festival

Drill teams from the University's three ROTC branches participated in the annual National Cherry Blossom Festival held in Washington, D.C., yesterday.

The Army drill team took part in the trick drills and will participate in the Cherry Blossom Parade tomorrow, Col. Ellis Richie, professor of military science, said. Ten other Army teams took part in the trick drill contest, he said, but the results of the contest have not yet been announced.

Recently the team took first

place in individual trick drill and third place in standard platoon drill at the Annual Pershing Rifle Fifth Regiment Competition; 21 Corps, in Indiantown Gap, Richie said.

The Navy and Air Force Drill teams also participated in the Cherry Blossom Festival trick drill event yesterday, but were unable to stay for the parade.
