

2 Students Fined

Two students were involved in a "mild" fight at 125 E. Nittany Ave. recently, Justice of the Peace Guy G. Mills said.

Robert S. Krauss, senior in journalism from Philadelphia, and Donald W. Lawson, junior in the Division of Counseling from Levittown, N.Y., were found guilty on disorderly conduct charges at a hearing, Mills said.

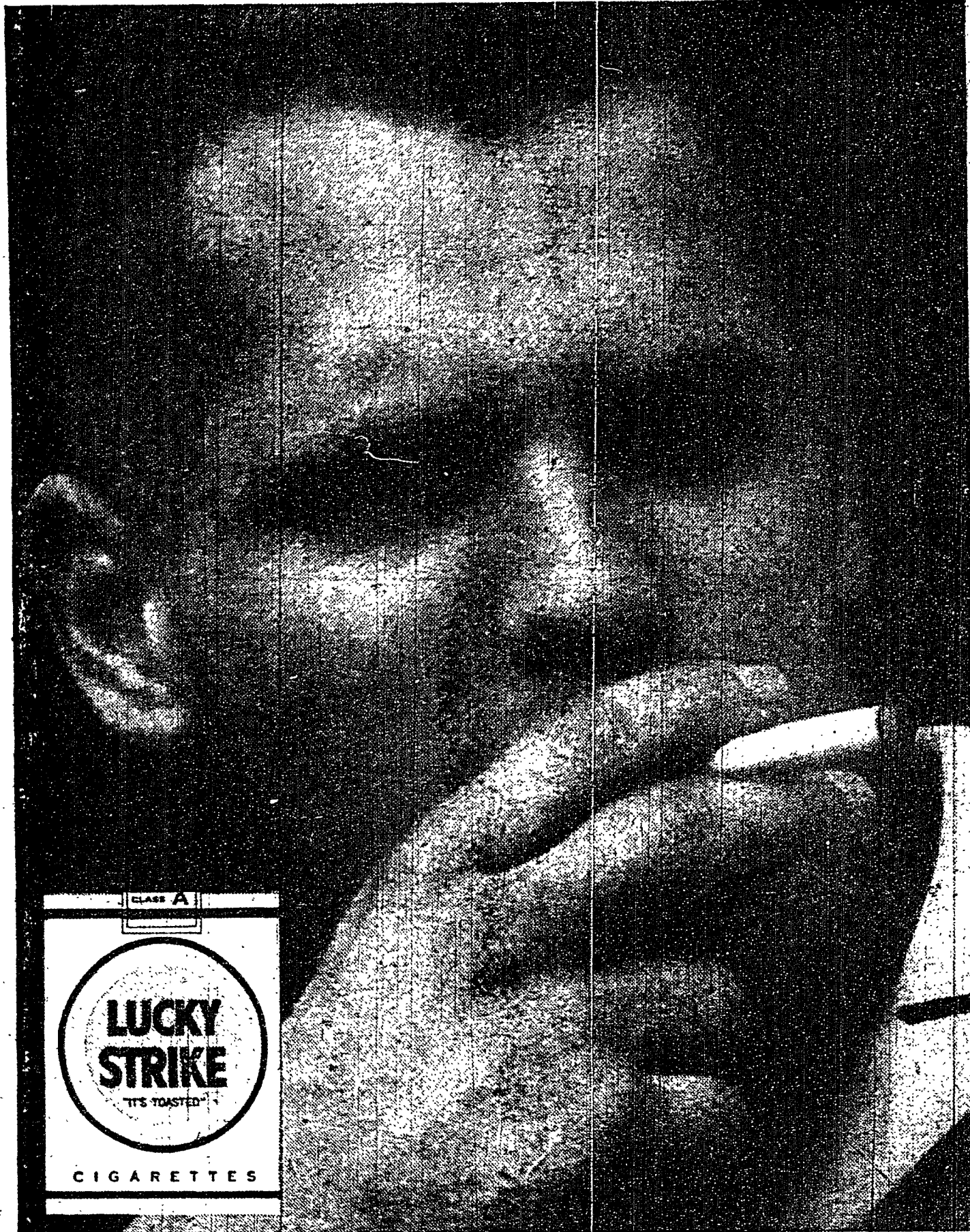
