

Walker Appointed Top Awards-- To Commissions

President Eric A. Walker has recently been appointed by President John F. Kennedy to two national commissions, according to Wilmer E. Kenworthy, executive assistant to the president. Walker will sit as a member of the panel of scientific and technical manpower of the President's Science Advisory Committee and the Board of Visitors of the United States Military Academy at West Point. The Board of Visitors is composed of Congressmen, educators and laymen, who yearly inspect the academy, Kenworthy said. Walker previously has served on the Board of Visitors of the Naval Academy at Annapolis, he added.
