Barbara Troxell, lyric soprano, and Raymond Brown, associate professor of music, will be soloists in the 15th annual spring concert to be presented by the Chapel Choir and the Symphony Orchestra at 8 p.m. Saturday in Schwab.

Tickets for the concert are being distributed free at the Hetzel Union desk. Ticket reservations will be held until 7:45 p.m. at which time the doors will be open to the public.

Miss Troxell and Brown will sing solos in "A German Requiem" by Johannes Brahms accompanied by the Chapel Choir under the direction of Willa C. Taylor.

THE SYMPHONY Orchestra, conducted by Theodore Karhan, will play "Sonata Pian e Forte" by Giovanni Gabrieli and Antonio Vivaldi's "Concerto for Two Trumpets and Strings."

Jay Himetson, Ellen Hassman and David Cole, guest cellists, will be heard in "Requiem for Three Violoncelli and Orchestra."

All have studied with the noted cellist, Orlando Cole.

Miss Troxell, now on the music faculty at Cornell University, is a 1937 graduate of the University and received a master's degree in music education here. She then studied with Elizabeth Schumann at the Curtis Institute.

She was recently named Penn State Woman of the Year for 1962 and will be recognized at ceremonies on June 16.

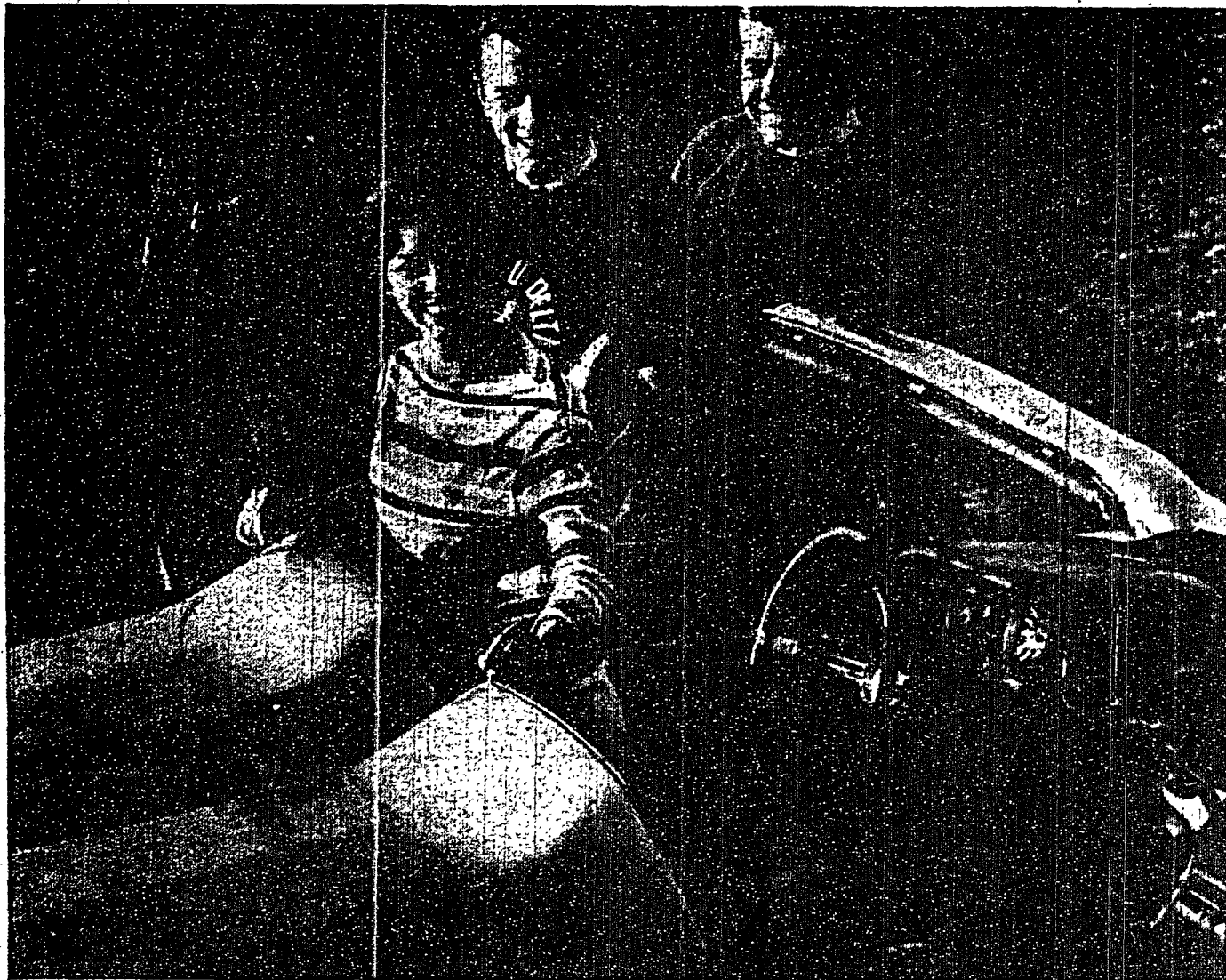
In 1950, she signed a contract with the Metropolitan Opera Co. She last sang with the Chapel Choir in 1952, when the same Brahms Requiem was performed.

Miss Troxell went to Europe in 1954, appearing most frequently in Germany and Austria. She returned to the United States last year and accepted the teaching position at Cornell, continuing her concert performances on a limited basis.

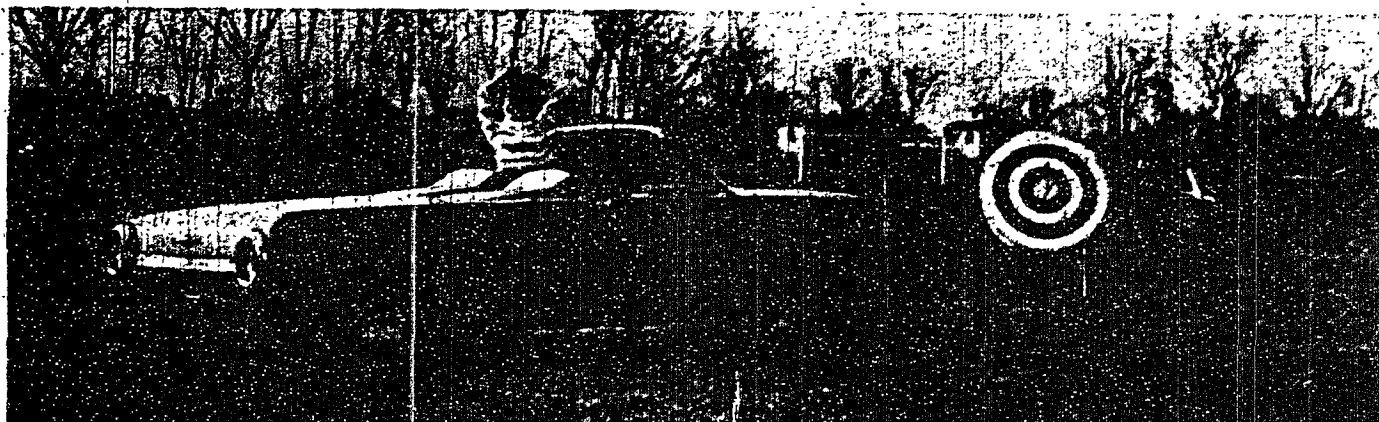
