

# Dilts Visits India on Asian Tour

Genevieve M. Dilts, associate director of the University Christian Association, is currently visiting New Delhi, India, in her 11-week tour of Asia.

Miss Dilts is a member of a group of 28 that is traveling through Asia on a travel-study seminar sponsored by the World University Service and the National Student Young Women's Christian Association.

The seminar, designed as a teaching program, will stress socio-economic, political, educational and religious life in Asia.

Miss Dilts said that participants have been doing firsthand study of the refugee situation in Hong Kong. They plan to visit Asian universities and the World Health Organization. Visits are planned to the YWCA and WUS projects in Bangkok, Thailand.

The group has already visited Rangoon, Burma, and several cities in India and Pakistan. The group will spend a month in Bangalore, India, where Indian leaders from government, higher education and the socio-economic scene will participate in the seminar.

The seminar is under the direction of Huston Smith of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
