# Hustle, Bustle of 'Rush' To Begin in November

The main topic of conversation among freshmen women, besides dates and studies, will soon be the prospects of sorority rush.

Sorority rush is exactly what it is named — "rush". It is a period of hustle and bustle, little studying, meeting people, remembering names and wondering what sororities will issue return invitations.

THE HECTIC LIFE begins in the middle of November and continues until Jan. 14, leaving time out for the Christmas recess. The first event is open houses on Nov. 11, 17 and 18. Any coed interested in participating in formal rush must attend the open houses.

Registration for formal rush will take place Jan. 3. A term average of 2.3 for freshmen and 2.00 for upperclass women and attendance at all open houses is required to participate in formal rush.

Rush starts in earnest with the first round of chatter dates on Jan. 5 and 6.

AT THE SECOND round of chatter dates on Jan. 8 and 9, there is even more "chattering."

At the end of chatter dates, the real decision-making begins. Sororities must decide who will be invited back and rushees must choose the three sororities which most interest them for Bermuda junctions.

Bermuda junctions are so named because the coeds wear Bermuda shorts, kilts or other sports clothes.

Jan. 13 is the crucial night for rushees and sororities. The rushees, dressed in cocktail dresses, may attend two formal coffee hours which are held in beautifully-decorated sorority suites. Re-

# IFC Schedules Rush Events

The Interfraternity Council will sponsor a rushing orientation program at 7:30 p.m. Thursday in Schwab for all freshmen men.

The rushing orientation program for all students with advanced standing will be held at 8 p.m. Tuesday in 121 Sparks.

OPEN HOUSES for students with advanced standing will be held from 8 to 9:45 p.m. Thursday. Further information about open houses will be available through orientation counselors.

The fraternity open houses for freshmen will be held from 2 to 5 p.m. Oct. 7, 14 and 28 and Nov. 11, and 9 p.m. to 1 a.m. Nov. 17.

Two open houses will be scheduled for each fraternity on the four different Sundays. Half of

the fraternities will be scheduled each Sunday.

There will be no personal contact of freshmen by fraternities, no advertising for open houses and no expenditure of funds for freshmen by fraternities.

FORMAL RUSH begins at 8 p.m., Jan. 6. Registration for rush will be held from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Jan. 3 and 4 in the Hetzel Union ballroom. Registration with the

fraternity affairs office is not compulsory.

The pledge date for eligible freshmen is Feb. 10. Informal rush will be held for the remainder of the term.

Under IFC rules, any student of advanced standing may pledge a fraternity at any time during the school year. Freshmen may not pledge until the pledging dates set by IFC.

THE PREFERENCES are matched through an IBM machine and bids are left in the rushees' room during the afternoon of Jan. 14. The coeds are ribboned with their sorority's colors at 7 that evening and thus ends rush.

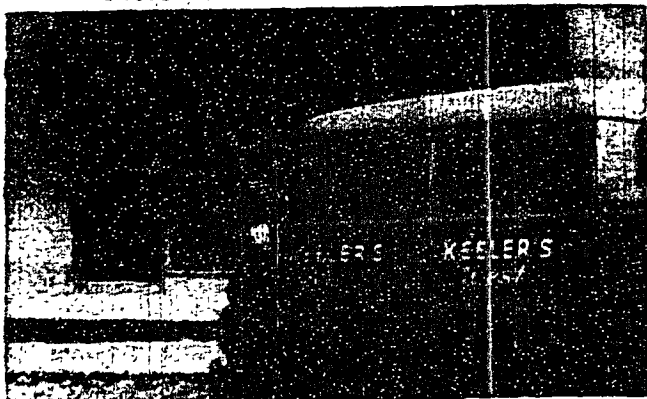
