A huge mass of abnormally chilly Canadian air should dominate the weather pattern east of the Mississippi for the next several days.

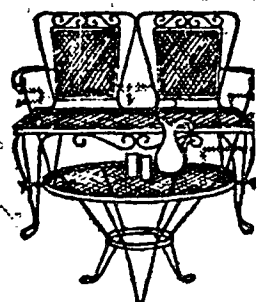
Today should be partly cloudy and cool with a few brief showers possible. The high will be near 63 degrees. Tonight should be clear and cold with a low of 37 degrees.
