

### Walker Submits University's Increased Budget Request

President Eric A. Walker Wednesday presented to Gov. David L. Lawrence's budget secretary the University's 1963 budget request, Walker announced in a statement yesterday.

The statement said the request represented a substantial increase over the current appropriation of

\$20 million. The exact amount, however, was not disclosed. Wilmer E. Kenworthy, executive assistant to the President, also declined to define what a substantial increase would be.

The increase was requested, the statement said, primarily for salary raises, research and to offset

the cost of increasing enrollment in accord with the University's long-range plan.

The University requested \$24 million for the current fiscal year, which ends June 30, 1963, but received \$20 million.

Walker said he had full opportunity to present the request.

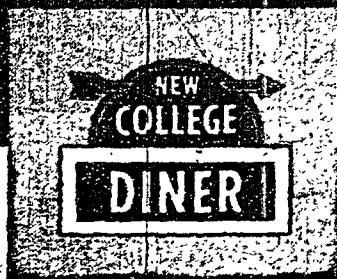
