

Prof Talks on Free Speech

If the democratic process is to work effectively in the United States, freedom of speech must be protected in three vital areas—peace, civil rights and civil liberties, Milnor Alexander, instructor in political science, said Tuesday.

Without the freedom of speech, people cannot keep informed on what is going on in the world. Dr. Alexander told a group of students interested in SENSE, Students for Peace.

The first and most important of the vital areas is that of peace. "We're sitting on top of a

stored surplus of weapons which could wipe out the human race," she explained.

"Can the cold war and arms race go on like this without change?" she asked.

She felt that the second area of prime importance is civil rights.

"WE ARE GETTING a bad name around the world. The Mississippi crisis, for example, has been in papers all over the world. The Negroes are not willing to accept a second class citizenship," she said.

Dr. Alexander said that in the third area of concern, civil liberties, some people believe the freedom of speech should be abridged in the name of national security.

The democratic process involves freedom of speech, she said, and without access to information on both sides of an issue, one cannot make a rational decision.

In order to help solve this problem, we must read widely, listen and debate. By doing these things, we can anticipate change and make rational and intelligent decisions, she concluded.
