

# Parties Register 239

Only one of the three political parties which registered members last night announced plans to participate in this fall's Undergraduate Student Government elections.

University Party, which registered 170 students, will help any party member with his campaign. Francis Conte (5th—political science—Everly Farms, Mass.) said last night after being elected party chairman. He stressed, however, that the party is not publicly endorsing any candidate.

Campus Party registered 40 members, and in a meeting im-

mediately following the registration, elected Robert Ferrugini (10th—education—Scranton) party chairman.

**THE THIRD GROUP**, Liberal Party, registered 29 members but did not elect a chairman. Before the meeting Anne Morris, party chairman, told a reporter from The Daily Collegian that she intended to resign and call for the election of a new chairman.

However, in a party meeting following registration, Miss Morris gave no indication that she was going to resign and no elections were held.

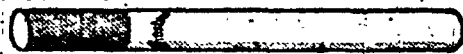
