

# Student Disciplined by Subcommittee

A first term student in engineering was placed on disciplinary probation by the Senate Subcommittee on Discipline in the only case reviewed by the Subcommittee at its weekly meeting Tuesday, Daniel R. Leasure, assistant dean of men, said yesterday.

Disciplinary probation involves limitation of participation in student activities and an official notation on the student's transcript, Leasure said.

THE STUDENT, a minor, was apprehended by State College Police in a local tavern when inspection of the establishment was

made last Saturday night. Under Borough ordinances, a minor is not allowed to frequent establishments which serve alcoholic beverages or to purchase them.

The student appeared before Justice of the Peace Guy G. Mills,

pleaded guilty to charges of purchasing alcoholic beverages and paid a fine of \$10 plus \$11.50 in costs.

The case was then turned over to the University, and the student was disciplined by the subcommittee.
